Sharing Love & Care to Homeless Youths

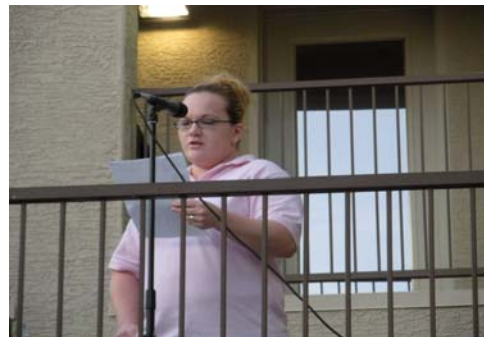

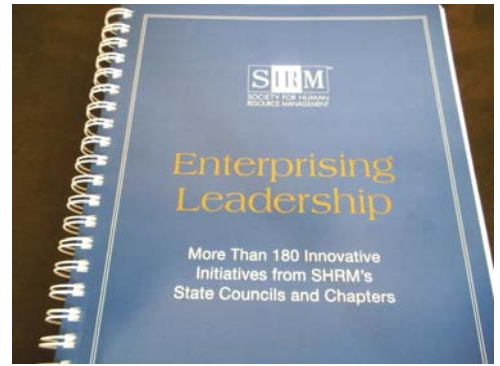
During the SHRM HQ Open House, Juntee met with Lon O'Neil, who is the new SHRM President & CEO to welcome him in his new role.

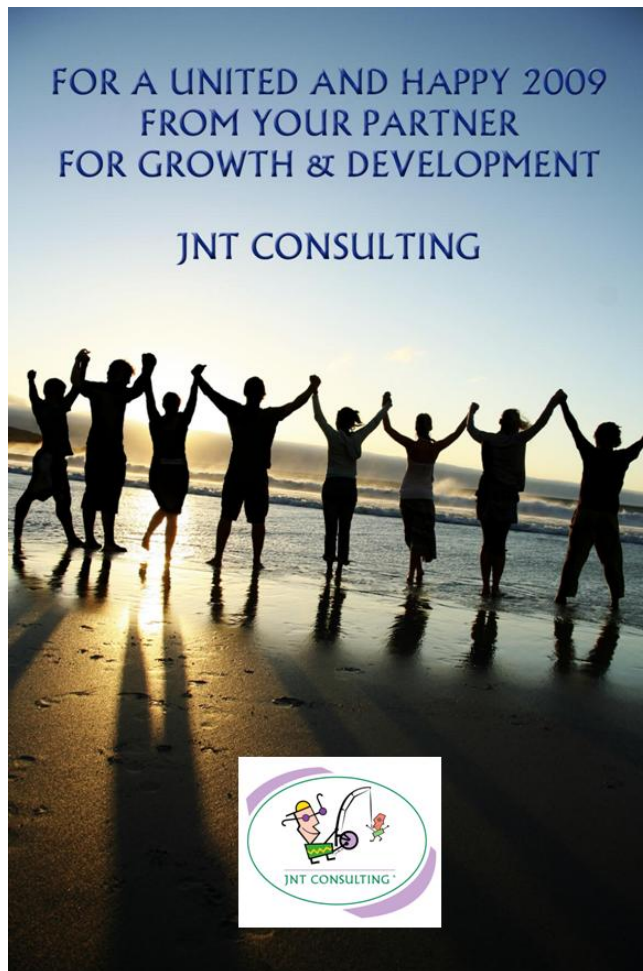
