USCIS Implements Premium Processing for EB3 Immigrant Petitions

Effective August 28, 2006 the USCIS has implemented the expansion of their Premium Processing Service, which allows US businesses to pay \$1,000.00 for an expedited processing of their case within 15 calendar day.

Per News Release dated August 18th—the service will begin accepting requests for petitions that are employment-based ‘preference’ with categories as EB-3 Professionals (these are immigrant professionals with bachelor degrees who are members of professions), and EB-3 Skilled Workers (immigrant workers who are capable in performing skills labor requiring at least two years of education, training or experiences).

Form I-140, Immigrant Petition for Alien Worker must be used by Employers filing for this type of petitions. Please note however, that ‘other workers’ under EB-3 category that do not require two years of education, training or experiences are not available to be petitioned under this Premium Processing.

The USCIS has revised as well the Form I-907, the Request for Premium Processing Services Form. All Petitions filed after August 28th must be using this new Form I-907 with revision date as August 28, 2006 and bears a designation ‘N’ shown after the revision date. This means that the Form I-907 with prior revision date is no longer accepted.

“Under the Premium Processing Service, USCIS guarantees petitioners that, for \$1,000.00 processing fee, it will issue either an approval notice, or where appropriate, a notice of intent to deny, a request for evidence or open an investigation for fraud or misrepresentation, within 15 calendar days of receipt. If the petition is not processed within ..

15 calendar days, USCIS will refund the \$1,000.00 fee and continue to process the request as part of the Premium Processing Service.”

It is advised that petitioners who participate in this program must use the dedicated phone number and email address to check on the status of their petition or may ask any other questions they may have.

PermitSure SM is a program and service that will guide and assist employers to comply with all requirements and maintenance of their immigration cases in conjunction with employment laws.

Features of PermitSure SM Program:

1. Identifies deficiencies of your employee's employment eligibility in conjunction to employment laws
2. Provides guidance in ways to comply with the requirements of Deemed Export Rule applicable to employees being hired from countries categorized as 'controlled countries' under the US Department of Commerce Bureau of Export Administration
3. Provides guidance in ways to comply with the requirements of employment visa applicable in the United States
4. Provides guidance in ways to comply with the requirements of employment eligibility in a foreign country
5. Provides guidance in ways to comply with the renewal of employment permit within the United States and or in another country
6. Provides guidance to the dependents of your employees who would like to gain employment within the country where they are currently assigned or living

Travel Requirements to United States

On Aug 11, 2006 the Dept of State announced the 'Travel Initiative' requiring all US Citizens, Canadian Citizens and Citizens of British Overseas Territory of Bermuda and Mexican Citizens to have a passport or other designated secure document to enter or re-enter the United States at airports and seaports by January 8, 2007.
